## **Elementary**

**Busy Buddies Preschool:** Please put names on these items: back pack they can open and close themselves (no wheels, please), clean gym shoes (that can be left at school) , 1 box kleenex, 1 pocket folder to travel back and forth each day.

**Special Friends Preschool** 2 boxes of Kleenex,. 1 glue stick and 1 bottle of glue. PLEASE LABEL ALL THE FOLLOWING ITEMS: Back pack, gym shoes (to be left at school), blanket, notebook, toothbrush, and toothpaste.

### **Mini Mustang Preschool List:**

PE shoes, backpack, blanket or towel for rest time, toothbrush, folder, 1 box tissue, 1 bottle glue, 1 box of 5 oz. cups

### **Kindergarten:**

No name on the following items, please: 1 box Kleenex, 3 - 4 oz. bottles of glue, 4 yellow No. 2 pencils. Please label the following items: 6 pocket folders, large tote bag, 4 boxes of crayons (8 count; basic colors, regular size), 1 box fine line markers (basic colors), 1 pair scissors (Fiskars blunt-type works well), 1 pencil box (plastic), gym shoes (slip-ons work best).

### **Grade One:**

Please write the student's name on the following items: 1 box of **sharpened** pencils , scissors, 6 **large** glue sticks, 1 **large** pencil bag or box to hold supplies, 4 boxes of 24 crayons, 1 Expo marker (any color except yellow), 1 **large** box Kleenex, 3 pocket folders, **1 green and 1 blue plastic pocket folder with prongs**, 1 box colored pencils, 1 tote bag without wheels , 1 pair of clean tennis shoes to leave for P.E. and some small pencil eraser tops, and supplies for 5th the classroom brought by students with last

names: A-H- 1 box **gallon** size zip lock plastic bags, I-Q- 1 box **sandwich** size zip lock plastic bags, R-Z- 1 box **snack** zip lock plastic bags. Thank you!

### **Grade Two:**

A clipboard, scissors, pencil bag, 1 white glue, 1 large glue stick, 1 ruler, 1 large box of Kleenex, 2 boxes of 8 crayons, 2 boxes of 24 crayons, 3 sharpened #2 yellow pencils, several unsharpened #2 pencils (not mechanical) 1 spiral notebook, 2 red pens, 4 Expo markers & eraser 7 double pocket folders (pockets on bottom - 1 red, 1 blue, 4 yellow, 1 green) 1 composition notebook 1 composition notebook 1 pair clean gym shoes. Student with last name beginning with: A-H= quart size Zip- lock bags, I-P= 3x5 lined note cards (1 Package) Q-Z= 1 package of #2 pencils

### **Grade Three:**

5 double pocket folders- no center prongs (1 yellow, 1 blue, 1 green, 2 of your choice), 2 spiral wide-lined notebook (NO Trapper keepers), 1 pkg. wide-lined notebook paper; post its (3x3), 1 clipboard, 2 red pens, glue, scissors, crayons (box of 48 or 64), markers, 3 SHARPENED # 2 pencils, eraser, 1 pencil bag (NO boxes), 2 LARGE boxes of kleenex, 4 Expo markers, eraser for individual-size marker board, and a pair of clean gym shoes. The following items are needed for the classroom art projects and celebrations. Students with the last names beginning with: A – E:1 pkg. snack size zip lock bags F – J:1 pkg. quart size zip lock bags; K – O:1 pkg. 3x5 lined cards; P-T: gallon size zip lock bags; U - Z :1 pkg. # 2 pencils.

**Grade Four:**

Each student will need 7 folders (red, blue, yellow, green, purple and two of your choice), 2 dry erase markers, 1 dry erase eraser, standard ruler, that has inches and cc/mm, scissors, 2 pens (not black ink), markers, pencil bag or box, colored pencils, several sharpened pencils (not mechanical), 4 spiral notebooks, 2 large boxes of kleenex, crayons, glue, clean gym shoes, clipboard, eraser, 1 pkgs. loose leaf notebook paper, 3x5 yellow post-its. Other important supplies have been divided into categories by the first letter of the student's last name:  
A-D: 1 pkg. 2x3 or 3x3 yellow post-it notes:  
E-K: pkg. Sandwich-size zip lock bags ; L-  
T-bottle of hand sanitizer (at least 8 oz.); U-  
Z- pkg. gallon sized zip lock bags. Please do NOT send mechanical pencils or 3 ring binders/ trapper keepers to school at ANYTIME during the school year. Thank you.
